## WHO:

High School Teachers from Title 1 Schools in the State of Florida Public School System.

## WHAT:

A week-long paid summer professional development program sponsored by the National Science Foundation (NSF) held at the University of Florida. This PD will include curriculum on learner-centered teaching, design thinking, and engineering design. Teachers will tour the NSF-funded natural hazard experimental facility, develop a project-based learning activity for their classrooms, and stay in contact with UF faculty to collaborate.
